## TINKERING WORKSHOPS

Reserve the Tinkering Studio for your group! | \$3 per student (9:00am - 12:00pm)

**ROCKETRY** (K- 12) Your mission is to create a rocket out of paper and tape that can fly with the power of air!

**PAPER CIRCUITS** (3 - 12) We put the “Art” in STEAM as students learn about electric circuits in creative ways.
